In the Sultan's palace and harem, we'll discover how women shaped Istanbul. After lunch, we'll wander through the ancient Egyptian Spice Bazaar and back streets, try Turkish coffee where it all began, enjoy Turkish Delight in the oldest shop in the country, now managed by the women of the family who started it and conclude in the lovely garden restaurant of our hotel for rich conversation and live music.

Byzantine Empire

We'll start our day with Empress Theodora, exploring a little known secret before visiting the famous Haghia Sophia. We'll see a 4th century underground cistern and learn about the women behind it before you have the choice of shopping in the Grand Bazar and experiencing the Turkish bath. Backward in Time

On Day 3, we'll take a domestic flight (1 hour) to the other worldly Cappadocia, the center of the country and the region of the Hittite civilization (the oldest known in the world). After settling in to our cave hotel, you can explore the quaint city of Göreme, before enjoying a folk dance show and Turkish feast in a cave restaurant.

We'll have a professional tour guide lead us through an underground city 8 stories deep, considering the reality of early Christian persecution and learning about Macrina the Elder, her daughter Emmelia, and her daughter Macrina the Younger. As we visit a monastery and hermitage that these women would have taught at, we'll learn how they shaped the foundation of our very faith. We'll enjoy the exotic landscape and rock formations that made this region so welcoming to early Christians.





Food and Culture Tour

Today we'll enjoy a late morning and leisurely stroll through Avanos, a nearby town famous for it's pottery. Try your hand at a potter's wheel, sample Cappadocian wine, learn about carpet designs, and enjoy tastes and sights with a local guide. We conclude our day with dinner on a terrace overlooking the magical city below.
